3RD YEAR INTERNSHIP

Five to six-month full-time internship for individual students. Students work on-site (minimum three, ideally five, days per week) and gain handson experience. While companies define most tasks, some assignments are required by the university.



GRADUATION INTERNSHIP

A five to six-month full-time internship where students work as entry-level professionals.

Companies define the responsibilities, with no predefined school assignments.

Students are expected to contribute professionally, ideally working on-site for at least three, preferably five, days per week.



RESEARCH THESIS PROJECT

In their final year, students complete a four to five-month individual research project, similar to a thesis. While they choose their own topic, they can also explore research questions proposed by companies. These projects are typically part-time and remote, with the possibility of guidance from our research center.
