



Are you leaving the Netherlands? To do an internship or study abroad semester? Or are you returning home indefinitely? There are things that you need to arrange before you leave. Read on and check the QR code, so we can fill you in!

LEAVING THE NETHERLANDS TEMPORARILY

If you're going abroad as part of your studies at HAN, you're temporarily moving abroad. Does this apply to you? Then you might need to take some actions:

EU/EEA students

- Depending on your situation, you might need to deregister from your local municipality.
- Do you have DUO? You might need to temporarily stop your student finance + travel product.

Non-EU/EEA students

- → To keep your residence permit for studies you need to be registered as a citizen residing in the Netherlands.
- Depending on your situation, you might need to apply for a postal address.

LEAVING THE NETHERLANDS INDEFINITELY

Are you leaving the Netherlands indefinitely? Because you recently graduated? Or you quit your studies?

EU/EEA students

- → Deregister from your local municipality.
- Cancel your housing contract, (health) insurance policies, mobile phone contract, bank account, etc.
- → Terminate your DUO student finance and travel product.

Are you an exchange student? Please check whether you need to have certain forms signed by HAN before you leave.

Non-EU/EEA students

- → Terminate your enrollment because of graduation or other reasons.
- → Deregister from your local municipality.
- → Return your residence permit to the IND.
