The activities during the International Week are specifically designed for our second-year undergraduate students at the School of Social Studies and the School of Allied Health. The program includes a wide range of educational activities such as presentations, seminars and (creative) workshops. Topics for workshops and presentations may include, but are not limited to:

Due to the large number of participants, the program will consist of parallel sessions. Therefore, we might ask you to repeat your contribution several times.
