#### **APPLICATION PROCEDURE**

After nomination, students will receive a link to our Online Application Form. Upon completion International Office will contact the student regarding acceptance.

#### **Application deadlines**

- Fall semester: 15 May
- Spring semester: 15 October

### ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The academic year starts in early September and ends in early July.

#### **SEMESTER DIVISION**

The academic year is divided into 2 semesters of 19 or 20 teaching weeks. A mandatory introduction program is organised in the week before the start of each semester.

#### Fall semester

Starts in early September and ends in late January The semester is divided into two terms:

- Term 1 runs from early September to mid-November
- Term 2 runs from mid-November to late January

#### Spring semester

Starts early February and ends early July The semester is divided into two terms:

- Term 3 runs from early February to mid-April
- Term 4 runs from mid-April to early July
