ACADEMIC CALENDAR

The academic year starts in early September and ends in early July.

SEMESTER DIVISION

The academic year is divided into 2 semesters of 19 or 20 teaching weeks. A mandotory introduction program is organised in the week before the start of each semester.

Fall semester

Starts in early September and ends in late January The semester is divided into two terms:

- Term 1 runs from early September to mid-November
- Term 2 runs from mid-November to late January

Spring semester

Starts early February and ends early July The semester is divided into two terms:

- Term 3 runs from early February to mid-April
- Term 4 runs from mid-April to early July
