Asylum-seeking children have the same rights to education as Dutch children or children who are treated in the same way e.g. children with a residence permit. Children below 12 go to elementary school either at the school nearby the AZC or at the AZC itself. Children between the age of 12 and 18 are first taught in an international class. When their level of Dutch is considered to be sufficient, they enrol in the suitable education programme. In this seminar we will look at the pros and cons the way education for refugee and asylum seeking children is organized in the Netherlands.
